Day 01	Kathmandu: Upon arrival at Kathmandu airport; our special vehicle will pick you up & proceed to Kathmandu hotel. Check in to the hotel. Get freshen up. Overnight stay at Kathmandu.
Day 02	Kathmandu: After breakfast full day sightseeing of Kathmandu: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pashupatinath Darshan (Hindus Temple) - [05:00am - 12:00noon - 05:00pm - 09:00pm] • Boudhanath Stupa (Temple of Buddhist) - [Open 24hours] • Budhanilkantha (Jal Naraya) - [05:00am - 06:00pm] • Soyambunath Stupa (Monkey Temple) from there we can view Kathmandu valley) - [09:00am - 06:00pm] • Durbar Square (Historical Temple and living god house) - [Open 24hours] Overnight stay at Kathmandu.
Day 03	Kathmandu - Chitwan [approx 5hrs/175km]: After breakfast check out from the hotel & proceed to Chitwan. Arrival at Chitwan. Check in to the hotel. Get freshen up. After lunch visit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tharu (Local) village tour (Optional) - The village tour is famous for personal observation of the Tharu community & their culture - • Museum (Optional) - The Museum is famous for study and observation of the Tharu community and their culture. The museum exhibits various equipments, utensils, dresses and daily items used by the Tharu people - Overnight stay at Chitwan.
Day 04	Chitwan - Pokhara [approx 5hrs/147km]: Activities & Elephant back ride safari in Chitwan (Optional): After breakfast proceed to visit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Elephant back ride safari (Optional) - Elephant ride is also the safest way to enter the jungle while one can observe wild animals and birds from up-close Return back to the hotel. 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Day 07	Pokhara – Kathmandu [approx 6hrs/204km]: Excursion Sunrise tour to Sarangkot in Pokhara – Transfer back to Kathmandu via Manakamana Temple darshan: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> SARANGKOT - Early in the morning 4 – 4.30 AM departure from hotel - drive up Sarangkot hill & few minute walk to observe a stunning view of Sunrise over snow caped mount Fish Tail & mount Annapurna range <p>After breakfast check out from the hotel & proceed to Kathmandu via:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Manakamana Darshan by cable car riding. – [Darshan Timing – 05:00am – 09:00pm & Cable Car Timing – 08:00am – 05:00pm] <p>After Manakamana Darshan proceed to Kathmandu - hotel check in Kathmandu.</p> <p>Overnight stay at Kathmandu.</p>
