**Nagarkot – 1N, Kathmandu – 2N, Janakpur – 1N, Chitwan – 2N, Pokhara – 2N, Jomsom – 1N**

Tour Itinerary	
<b>Day 01</b>	<p><b>Kathmandu Airport – Nagarkot [approx 1hrs 30min/27km]:</b> Upon arrival at Kathmandu Airport; our special vehicle will pick you up &amp; to Nagarkot &amp; on the way to Bhaktapur.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bhaktapur Part of the Malla regime known as Bhadgaon famous for its preservation of traditions &amp; culture. It is also one of the UNESCO heritage site. After the sightseeing travel to Nagarkot, situated at an altitude of 2175 m above the sea level. It offers grandstand panorama of Dhaulagiri in the west, Kanchenjunga in the east.</li> </ul> <p>You can see more than five of the world's tallest mountains like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lhotse (8516 m), Cho Oyu (8201 m), Makalu (8463 m) and Manaslu (8163 m) and many other lesser summits including the highest peak Mt. Everest (8848 m). The magnificent view of the snow peaks especially during sunset &amp; sunrise fills one with awe. View the gorgeous sunset from here.</li> </ul> <p><b>Overnight stay at Nagarkot.</b></p>
<b>Day 02</b>	<p><b>Nagarkot – Kathmandu City Sightseeing [approx 1hrs 30min/27km]:</b> After breakfast check out from the hotel &amp; proceed to Kathmandu. Upon Arrival full day sightseeing of Kathmandu valley which includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pashupatinath Darshan (Hindus Temple) – [05:00am – 12:00noon – 05:00pm – 09:00pm]</li> <li>Boudhanath Stupa (Temple of Buddhist) – [Open 24hours]</li> <li>Budhanilkantha (Jal Naraya) – [05:00am - 06:00pm]</li> <li>Soyambunath Stupa (Monkey Temple) from there we can view Kathmandu valley) – [09:00am - 06:00pm]</li> <li>Durbar Square (Historical Temple and living god house) – [Open 24hours]</li> </ul> <p><b>Overnight stay at Kathmandu.</b></p>
<b>Day 03</b>	<p><b>Kathmandu – Janakpur [approx 6hrs/225km]:</b> After breakfast check out from the hotel &amp; proceed to Janakpur. Arrival at Janakpur. Check in to the hotel. Evening visit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bhutnath Temple</li> <li>Ganga Sagar (Pond)</li> <li>Dhanush Sagar (Pond).</li> </ul> <p><b>Overnight stay at Janakpur</b></p>
<b>Day 04</b>	<p><b>Janakpur – Chitwan [approx 7hrs/260km]:</b> Early morning Janakpur sightseeing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Janaki Temple (Naulakha Mandir)</li> <li>Ram Mandir &amp; Vivaha Mandap</li> </ul> <p>Back to hotel have breakfast. After breakfast check out from the hotel &amp; proceed to Chitwan. Arrival at Chitwan. Check in to the hotel. Get freshen up. <b>Chitwan National Park.</b> Lunch at hotel – After lunch visit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Tharu (Local) village tour-</b> The village tour is famous for personal observation of the Tharu community &amp; their culture. <b>Museum</b> the Museum is famous for study and observation of the Tharu community and their culture. The museum exhibits various equipment, utensils, dresses and daily items used by the Tharu people. <b>Overnight stay Chitwan.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Day 05</b>	<p><b>Chitwan:</b> After breakfast proceed for sightseeing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Canoe trip</b> – Canoe ride along the Rapti River inside the Chitwan National Park gives an opportunity to take a close view of crocodiles and other wild animals at Chitwan National Park.</li> <li><b>Jungle Walk –Elephant Bathing</b> – One can play with the Elephants and dive in the river from the back of elephant while it is bathing</li> </ul> <p>Return back to the hotel. Have lunch at hotel. After lunch proceed to visit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Elephant back ride safari or Jeep Safari</b> – Elephant ride /Jeep safari is also the safest way to enter the jungle while one can observe wild animals and birds from up – close.</li> </ul> <p><b>Overnight stay at Chitwan.</b></p>



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<b>Day 06</b>	<b>Chitwan – Pokhara [approx 4hrs/158km]:</b> After breakfast proceed to visit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Bird watching - Elephant Breeding centre</b></li> </ul> Hotel check out from the hotel & proceed to Pokhara. Arrival at Pokhara. Check in to the hotel. Get freshen up. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Evening free for own activities. <b>Overnight stay at Pokhara.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Day 07</b>	<b>Pokhara – Jomsom [approx 8hrs/158km]:</b> After breakfast check out from the hotel & proceed to Pokhara airport. – Pokhara - Jomsom by Air – At an height of 2754 meters /9000 feet lies the western region of Nepal (weather conditions – Month & Climate – Jan & Feb – Slightly Windy – Mar, Apr & May – Excellent – Jun, Jul & Aug – Slightly Warm / rainy – Sep, Oct, Nov & Dec – Slightly cold & clear. Pick up from Jomsom airport proceed to Jomsom hotel. Check in hotel. Get freshen up & proceed to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Muktinath Darshan – Transfer to Jomsom – Muktinath by sharing Jeep. Arrived Muktinath. Half an hour walk to Temple from Jeep stand – Darshan, Puja &amp; Running Tap water Bath – Back to Jomsom. <b>Overnight stay at Jomsom.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Day 08</b>	<b>Jomsom – Pokhara:</b> After breakfast - Departure transfer to Jomsom airport for Pokhara flight - Jomsom/Pokhara by air. Arrival transfer from Pokhara airport. Check in to the hotel. Get freshen up. Half day local sightseeing Pokhara: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dave's fall – [06:00am – 07:00pm]</li> <li>Gupteswore Cave – [06:00am – 06:00pm]</li> <li>Bindhabasini temple – [Open 24hours]</li> <li>Seti River</li> <li>Pokhara Museum</li> <li>Enjoy boating on Fewa Lake. <b>Overnight stay at Pokhara</b></li> </ul>
<b>Day 09</b>	<b>Pokhara – Sarangkot – Kathmandu [approx 6hrs/205km]:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Early in the morning 4 – 4.30 AM departure from hotel - drive up Sarangkot hill &amp; few minute walk to observe a stunning view of Sunrise over snow capped mount Fish Tail &amp; mount Annapurna range (about 02 hrs)</li> </ul> Return back to the hotel. Have breakfast. After breakfast check out from the hotel & proceed to Kathmandu. Kathmandu via: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Manakamana Darshan by cable car riding. – [Darshan Timing – 05:00am – 09:00pm &amp; Cable Car Timing – 08:00am – 05:00pm]</li> </ul> After darshan proceed to Kathmandu. Arrival at Kathmandu. Check in to the hotel. Get freshen up. <b>Overnight stay at Kathmandu.</b>
<b>Day 10</b>	<b>Kathmandu:</b> After breakfast check out from the hotel & proceed to Kathmandu airport to board the flight for hometown.
